

From M4 Junction 18 avoiding Bath City Centre (not suitable for HGVs) 🚝

- Leave the M4 at Junction 18 and join the A46 southbound, signposted Bath.
- Continue on this road until the junction with the A420 and from the roundabout take the third exit.
- After approximately 0.8 mile turn left onto Freezinghill Lane.
- At the T-junction continue left up the hill.
- After passing Bath Racecourse on the right, turn right down Lansdown Lane.
- At the roundabout take the first exit onto the High Street.
- After the pedestrian crossing turn right onto Anchor Road leading to Penn Hill
- At the end of the road turn left onto the A431 Kelston Road.
- Take the first right turn (hairpin) onto Old Newbridge Hill.
- At the crossroads continue straight ahead onto Brassmill Lane. See *

From Salisbury 🚘

- Leave Salisbury on the A36 and continue on this road for approximately forty miles until reaching Bath.
- Once in Bath, turn left at the first roundabout and go straight across the second roundabout (still the A36).
- Follow this road until you come to a large roundabout under railway arches, go straight across and take the second exit, turning left onto the Lower Bristol Road
- Continue along the A36 for 2.5 miles through several sets of traffic lights. After passing the traffic lights outside McDonalds, continue along the A36 until you are able to turn right onto the A4 (signposted Newbridge) at some traffic lights.
- After crossing the river, take the first right into Brassmill Lane. See

From Bristol

- Leave Bristol on the A4 eastbound, signposted Bath.
- Continue for approximately 11 miles until the junction with the A36. Stay on the A4 and after crossing over the river take the first right into Brassmill
- Lane. See *
